

## Snow Industry Partners Support The EPA Carbon Standards

*The ski industry is seizing an opportunity to transition to a new, economically-beneficial, clean energy economy.*

On June 19, 2014, snow industry corporations and ski resorts joined together with Protect Our Winters to support the recent EPA carbon standards announced June 2.

The letter, sent to President Barack Obama, and endorsed by some of the most influential brands in snow sports, applauded the federal government's efforts to reduce carbon pollution under the Clean Air Act. The standards propose limits on carbon emissions from existing power plants, reducing carbon emissions 30% below 2005 levels.
